### **In-text citation**

If you refer to an author who has contributed/produced a chapter in an edited book you will need to cite their name in the body of your work like this:

(Marshall, 1975)

As noted by Marshall (1975)...

"Direct quotations are placed in double quotations marks" (Author's Surname, Year of Publication, p. – followed by page number – in brackets)"

## **Reference in bibliography**

#### Book

FAMILY/SURNAME, Initials. (Year of publication - in brackets) *Book Title* - in italics or underlined. Series title and volume - if applicable. Edition - if not the first. Place of Publication: Publisher.

Two and more authors: FAMILY/SURNAME, Initials., FAMILY/SURNAME, Initials. and

FAMILY/SURNAME, Initials. (Year of publication - in brackets) *Book Title* - in italics or underlined. Series title and volume - if applicable. Edition - if not the first. Place of Publication: Publisher.

## Chapter in a Book

FAMILY/SURNAME, Initials. (Year of publication - in brackets) Title of chapter/contribution. In: Author or Editor of Publication - Surname, Initials with (ed.) or (eds.) – in brackets, if relevant. *Book Title* - in italics or underlined. Series title and volume - if applicable. Edition - if not the first. Place of Publication: Publisher.

## Journal article (printed)

FAMILY/SURNAME, Initials. (Publication year) Title of article. *Title of journal*. Volume number (Part number/month). p. page numbers of the article.

Ex:

BLANKE, T., HEDGES, M. and DUNN, S. (2009) Arts and humanities e-science. Current practices and future challenges. Future Generation Computer Systems. 25 (4). p. 474-480.

## Journal article (electronic/online)

FAMILY/SURNAME, Initials. (Publication year) Title of article. *Title of journal*. [Online] Name of Database the article is from if appropriate. Volume number (Part number/month). p. page numbers of the article. Available from: URL. [Accessed: date viewed in square].

Ex:

SVENSSON, P. (2009) Humanities computing as digital humanities. *Digital Humanities Quarterly* 3 (3). Available from: http://www.digitalhumanities.org/dhq/vol/3/3/000065/000065.html. [Accessed: 14th July 2014].

## **Conference** Paper

FAMILY/SURNAME, Initials or AUTHORING GROUP. (Year of publication - in brackets) Title of Paper. In: FAMILY/SURNAME, Initials. of author or editor of book (ed.) or (eds.). *Full Title of Conference*. Series title and numbers if applicable. Location and Date of Conference. Place of Publication: Publisher. Page numbers of paper.

Ex:

## E-Book

FAMILY/SURNAME, Initials. (Publication year) *Book title - italicised or* underlined. [Online] Series title and volume if applicable. Edition. Place of publication: Publisher. Available from: URL. [Accessed: date].

Ex:

BÖRNER, W., UHLIRZ, S. (2013) *Proceedings of the 17th International Conference on Cultural Heritage and New Technologies 2012 (CHNT 17, 2012)*. Vienn: Museen der Stadt Wien. Available from: <u>http://www.chnt.at/proceedings-chnt-17/</u>. [Accessed: 14th July 2014].

#### Website, web-document, computer program tutorial

Author of website FAMILY/SURNAME, Initials or WEBSITE name if no author is available. (Year - in brackets) *Title of website in italics or underlined*. Any numbers if necessary or available if website is part of a series. [Online] Available from: URL. [Accessed: date].

Ex:

NATIONAL SCIENCE FOUNDATION. (2011) *Planning Archaeological Infrastructure for Integrative Science*. NSF Award Number 1202413 November 2011. [Online] <u>http://www.nsf.gov/awardsearch/showAward</u>. [Accessed: 14th July 2014].
