

CAA Norway Annual report 2015

CAA Norway has organized an annual event every year since the start of the national chapter in 2008. The events alternate every other year between workshop and two-day conference. CAA-N arranged a workshop with the theme Photogrammetry and 3D-documentation in Archaeology on the 13th October 2015 at the University campus in Oslo. The workshop was arranged in cooperation with the Institute of Archaeology, Conservation studies and History (IAKH) and the Museum of Cultural History (KHM), University of Oslo.

Presenters at the event came from Museum of Cultural History, the University of Oslo, The Norwegian Maritime Museum in Oslo, The National Maritime Museum in Gdansk and Tromsø University Museum. The workshop was also part of the bilateral cooperation between the National Maritime Museum in Gdansk and the Museum of Cultural History funded by EEA and Norway Grants projects.
